The Madison County School District will soon consider a measure to continue a 1.500 mill property tax for the capital outlay projects listed herein.

This tax is in addition to the school board's proposed tax of **4.509** mills for operating expenses and is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

THE PROPOSED COMBINED SCHOOL BOARD TAX INCREASE FOR BOTH OPERATING EXPENSES AND CAPITAL OUTLAY IS SHOWN IN THE ADJACENT NOTICE.

The capital outlay tax will generate approximately \$1,221,730 to be used for the following allowable projects:

Repair and upgrade to building fire alarm systems
Chiller repairs and replacement at Madison County Central School
Chiller repairs and replacement at Madison County High School
Repairs and/or replacement to air conditions as Lee, Pinetta and Greenville Elementary
Retro fit or repair facilities to meet CDC Guidelines for all Schools and District Offices.
